

ATTENTION ALL HUMAN SERVICE & HOME HEALTH DIRECT CARE WORKERS

Do you work for an organization funded or licensed by a state agency?
Do you provide direct care at a home-based or community-based human service organization?

You may qualify for between \$3,000-\$30,000 in student loan debt **repayment** through the MA Repay Program.

Please note, to be eligible for this program you must make less than 50% of the area median income (AMI) for a single-person household as defined by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

Eligibility requirements:

+ Must agree to a service commitment of 1-3 years with an employer funded or licensed by one of the following state agencies:
