1	AN ACT relating to child-care centers in Kentucky.
2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS 199.892 TO 199.8996 IS CREATED
4	TO READ AS FOLLOWS:
5	(1) Child-care centers licensed pursuant to KRS 199.896 shall have the following
6	standards:
7	(a) Nutrition standards, if the child-care center provides food, that are
8	consistent with the meal and snack patterns of the most recent version of
9	the United States Department of Agriculture's Food and Nutrition Service
10	standards for the Child and Adult Care Food Program. These nutrition
11	standards do not apply to food that is brought from a child's home;
12	(b) Physical activity standards;
13	(c) Screen time standards; and
14	(d) Sugary drink standards.
15	(2) The cabinet shall, within ninety (90) days of the effective date of this Act.
16	promulgate administrative regulations, in consultation with the Kentucky Early
17	Childhood Advisory Council established pursuant to KRS 200.700, the Kentucky
18	Child Care Advisory Council established pursuant to KRS 199.8983, and state
19	and national organizations that have expertise in nutrition, physical activity,
20	screen time, and sugary drink standards, to establish the requirements and
21	procedures for the implementation of the standards established in this section.
