

Project SX Project EX Training

A full-day training. Project EX is a school-based, tobacco-use cessation program for high school youth (ages 14-19 years).

The 8-session curriculum is delivered over a 6-week period. It emphasizes coping with stress, dealing with nicotine withdrawal, relaxation techniques, and how to avoid relapse. It aims to teach self-control, anger management, mood management, and goal setting techniques, and it provides self-esteem enhancement.

At the completion of the program, youth will be able to:

- Stop or reduce cigarette smoking
- State accurate information about environmental, social physiological, and emotional consequences of tobacco use
