

HB 951: YOU ASKED, WE ANSWERED:

It's Time to Let HB951 Go to a Vote

To Senator Kim Ward: it is time to let HB 951 go to a vote. You have asked many questions about a potential revival window in Pennsylvania, including:

• What purpose does a window serve?

On May 19, 2021, CHILD USA published and shared a <u>Position Paper</u> on revival windows, addressing your questions on:

- o current research explaining the impact of abuse on victims and the scientific reality of delayed disclosure;
- o a history of statute of limitations reform in the United States;
- o the three compelling purposes served by creating a window for survivors;
- o and an in-depth analysis of the constitutionality of revival laws in Pennsylvania.

• What are other states doing about statute of limitations reform?

In almost all of CHILD USA's statute of limitations reform documents, we cite to a tracker that follows legislative reform happening in each state during the legislative session, and to a report on the history of statute of limitations reform to provide a national context for what states are reforming their laws.

• What is the constitutionality of other revival windows?

On May 20, 2021, we provided your office with <u>analysis of other revival windows</u>, whether they were challenged, and whether and why they were upheld as constitutional.

• What is the caselaw in Pennsylvania addressing revival of civil claims?

On May 25, 2021, we provided your office with a <u>bulleted list of caselaw</u> showing that it is constitutional to create a revival window in Pennsylvania.

Senator Kim Ward, it is time to do your job. Bring HB 951 to the floor for a vote, and allow victims their opportunity to access long-awaited justice.
