





## DIRECT CARE / HEALTH CARE BONUSES

Up to \$3,000 bonuses for recruitment and retention of direct care and health care workers

This is not about work during the pandemic \*\*\*





## DIRECT CARE / HEALTH CARE BONUSES

- frontline healthcare and mental hygiene practitioners, technicians, assistants, and aides;
- 2. that provides hands on health or care services to individuals;
- 3. that works full-time, part-time, is salaried or hourly, or temporary basis or as an independent contractor;
- 4. for an eligible employer; and
- 5. earns a base salary of less than \$125,000.

#### **ELIGIBLE TITLES**

## Questions to ask if you think a title should be included:

- 1. Do they perform direct patient care as part of their normal duties?
- 2. Did they perform direct patient care only during Covid-19 surges, or during high volume vaccination drives?
- 3. Is the position difficult to recruit for or retain workers in?



- Cost-Of-Living-Adjustment (NFPs)
- Nurses' Across New York Loan Forgiveness
- Homecare Wages Increase

#### BUDGET HIGHLIGHTS-CHILD CARE

Increase in Rate Paid to Providers

Additional Round of Stabilization Grants

• Increased Eligibility for Child Care Subsidies

• \$83,250 eligibility limit for a family of four





### BUDGET HIGHLIGHTS-LOCAL GOVERNMENTS

- Funding
  - General state aid
  - Local Public Health Departments
  - Road / Bridge Funding





### BUDGET HIGHLIGHTS-REVENUE

- Environmental Bond Act
  - \$4.2 billion
  - On the ballot in November
- Gas Tax Suspension
  - \$0.16 savings per gallon
- Property Tax Rebate
