- Include a "Skills and Interests" section. We do not expect you to have relevant experience for the internship, so we encourage you to include any information that will help us to get to know you!

COVER LETTER

- Please keep your cover letter to approximately one side of A4.
- Use the **prompt questions** outlined in the job advert to structure your cover letter.
- Of course, we want to see enthusiasm for Disney! But more importantly, we want to know why you think your skills and attributes mean you are suitable for the role and what it is about that role specifically that interests you.
- Double-check spelling and grammar before submitting your application.
- We do not accept applications without a cover letter.
- Remember, your cover letter is not just about why Disney should choose you. We also want to hear what you will gain from this experience. We'd love to hear about your future career goals and how this opportunity will help you achieve them!
