We've worked closely with Emergency Coverage Corporation (ECC) for several months, but we haven't reached an agreement to keep them in your clients' plans.

Starting February 9, 2022, ECC doctors will not be in your clients' plans. However, if your clients' employees receive emergency care from ECC doctors, their plans will cover the care at the same level as care provided by doctors in their plan's network. Based on Virginia's new surprise billing law, ECC doctors can't bill them for the difference between what their plan covers and what ECC charges for the care.
