 - Review the timeline, mark your calendar for an overview session, and carefully review the engineering orientation resources.
- 2. Complete all items on the **Engineering Orientation Checklist**
 - Send all official high school, college, and university transcripts
 - Send all years of official score reports for AP, IB, CLEP, etc.
 - o Complete a self-evaluation of transfer credits
 - Look up your academic advisor assignment on HokieSpa

3. Check your VT email daily
