Recommendations from the Recanvass/Recount Committee to the SCC for a resolution to be applied to official recanvass requests. The resolution accepting these recommendations passed on Thursday, February 13, 2020.

- 1. **Math Worksheet does not match the publicly reported results:** The publicly reported results should be corrected to match the Math Caucus Worksheet.
- 2. The viability was miscalculated in the caucus: The viability number should not be changed. Most commonly the issue is that the caucus rounded down and not up as they should have. However, if this number were to be changed the alignments would change. Therefore, decisions made by individuals would be made void and some of the groups that were considered viable would now not be considered viable. This would lead to disenfranchising some of the caucusgoers because they now cannot realign, since the caucusgoers believed they were in a viable group.
- 3. **The caucus misapplied the rules:** This is most often seen in rounding issues applying the choices made in the room with rounding the numbers up or down. This is also seen when the results showed too few or too many delegates. The rules from the DSP should be applied correctly. The rules being applied does not change the decisions made by caucusgoers since it is only applied to the final alignment numbers.
- 4. What to do if a game of chance is needed: If changes are made during the Recanvass because the rules were applied incorrectly and a coin flip is now required, a Administrator should administer a game of chance. This again, does not change the choice of the caucusgoers and respects the certification of the alignments.
