

**With support from the ECMC Foundation, JBAY is funding seven California Community Colleges to launch or expand their basic needs centers.**

**The campuses plan to utilize grant funding as follows:**

**Allan Hancock Community College** will be launching an emergency housing project, utilizing hotel vouchers.

**Lake Tahoe Community College** will be expanding their present basic needs center to serve more students.

**Mission College** will be funding peer mentors to expand basic needs access to students.

**Mt. San Antonio College** will be making emergency grants to students, encompassing a variety of basic needs, and increasing outreach capacity.

**Napa Valley Community College** will be centralizing their basic needs efforts and increasing staffing.

**San Diego Community College** will be expanding upon existing basic needs work to launch a more complete center.

**San Joaquin Delta College** will be centralizing basic needs efforts into a basic needs center and providing students with emergency grants.
