With support from the ECMC Foundation, JBAY is funding seven California Community Colleges to launch or expand their basic needs centers.

The campuses plan to utilize grant funding as follows:

Allan Hancock Community College will be launching an emergency housing project, utilizing hotel vouchers.

Lake Tahoe Community College will be expanding their present basic needs center to serve more students.

Mission College will be funding peer mentors to expand basic needs access to students.

Mt. San Antonio College will be making emergency grants to students, encompassing a variety of basic needs, and increasing outreach capacity.

Napa Valley Community College will be centralizing their basic needs efforts and increasing staffing.

San Diego Community College will be expanding upon existing basic needs work to launch a more complete center.

San Joaquin Delta College will be centralizing basic needs efforts into a basic needs center and providing students with emergency grants.
