Directions to Residence Halls

Caughlin, Good Counsel, Katharine, McGuire and Moriarty Halls: If traveling from Route 476 (traveling East on Route 30), turn right into Parking Lot L2 via the driveway directly after Farrell Hall. If traveling West on Route 30, turn left into Parking Lot L-2 at St. Thomas Way.

Stanford and St. Monica Halls: If traveling from Route 476 (traveling East on Route 30), travel past St. Thomas Way and the intersection at Ithan Avenue. You will be directed by Public Safety to make a left at Galberry Hall into the A-2 Parking Lot. If traveling West on Route 30, make a right into the A-2 Parking Lot at Galberry Hall.

Delurey, O'Dwyer and Simpson Halls: Enter at the Delurey Gate entrance on Spring Mill Road/Route 320.

Alumni and Fedigan Halls: Enter at the Fedigan Gate entrance on Spring Mill Road/Route 320.

St. Mary's Hall: Enter at the West Campus Gate entrance on Spring Mill Road/Route 320.

***Please display your hang tag from your rear view mirror as you enter your designated lot. Vehicles with hang tags will be directed to the designated hall by Public Safety.**

What to Bring

- Plastic Containers with lids (for food storage)/Wastebasket

Please Do Not Bring...

- Platform Beds or Lofts/Cushioned or other Headboards for Beds.
- Candles (decorative or functional)
- Hot Plates/Toaster Ovens/Any appliance with exposed heating elements/Crock Pots
- Air Conditioning Units/Space Heaters
- Pets
- Halogen Lamps
- Cinder Blocks/Bed Risers (or other items designed to raise the height of beds or furniture Height of bed frames can be adjusted)
- Wall Mounted Shelves or items that require permanent fixture to walls or furniture/Adhesive Contact Paper

ARRIVING ON CAMPUS

When You Arrive At Your Residence Hall

When you arrive at your residence hall, please quickly unload your belongings. You will then be directed to immediately move your car to a campus parking lot. As a reminder, you will not be permitted to remain parked next to your assigned residence hall or return to that area until Friday evening after move-in is complete for all residents.

- After you unload your belongings, check-in and pick up your Wildcard at the entrance to your residence hall. Your Wildcard will allow you access to both your residence hall and your room.
- Residence Life and Orientation staff will be available at your hall to assist you and answer questions.
- Please label your bags/items with your name, residence hall and room number.
- Please dispose of your recycling and trash according to the posted signs outside your building.

Room Accessories

The Office for Residence Life has partnered with the Villanova University Shop to offer students the opportunity to purchase room accessories. Items include carpets, bedding, shower and bath supplies, and desk accessories and can be purchased on the Villanova University Shop website. Mail Services

Laundry Services

Each residence hall housing new students is equipped with pay-per-use washers and dryers. Payment is made via Wildcard. Students may also choose to subscribe to a laundry wash and fold service offered by Tide.

Cable and Streaming Television

XFINITY On Campus

XFINITY On Campus delivers live streaming TV directly to computers and select mobile and video streaming devices. Designed exclusively for residential students, XFINITY On Campus provides live TV from a preselected channel line-up and content on-demand. Each student is able to upgrade their streaming service through an exclusive portal designed for Villanova students.

XFINITY Cable TV

Providing over 100 channels, Xfinity TV is delivered via coaxial cable to each residence hall (except The Commons). Students can watch this channel line-up by connecting their TV directly to the coaxial cable jack in their room.

Students must provide their own coaxial cable cord and will need to re-program their channel line-up upon set-up of their TV. Search for the make and model of your TV online to find instructions on how to program your TV for channel line-up.
