Scholarship Program Guidelines

Recipients of the Scholarship Awards Will Have the Choice of Either a Full Tuition Reimbursement towards the CI 101 Course Hosted by the CT CCIM Chapter in the Fall of 2022 or a \$1,000 Tuition Reimbursement Towards a CCIM Designation Course Taken Online or Hosted by Another Chapter.

The CT CCIM course scholarship was created to support qualified real estate professionals in their efforts to achieve the CCIM designation. Recipient should exemplify the high caliber of professionals that comprise the CCIM Institute.

Scholarship Selection Criteria

Includes the following:

- Each applicant should be able to demonstrate a commitment to a commercial real estate career (see application).
- Each applicant should be able to demonstrate active participation with the CT CCIM Chapter, such as attending events, volunteering or as a due paying member (see application).
- Recipient of this scholarship should have a need for financial assistance.

Scholarship Value

Recipient will have the choice to receive either a full-tuition reimbursement for the CI 101 course hosted by the CT CCIM Chapter in the fall of 2022 valued between **\$1,200** (CCIM Member) and **\$1,735** (Non- Member) OR a **\$1,000** reimbursement to offset the

cost of **one** of the following CCIM designation courses: **CI 101, CI 102, CI 103 or CI 104** taken online or hosted by another CCIM Chapter.

Procedure

Applications are submitted directly to the CT CCIM Chapter through bernadette@nhmrealtors.com. Questions regarding the process or application should also be directed there. Upon successful completion of one of the CCIM designation courses, the scholarship winner should contact bernadette@nhmrealtors.com to provide evidence of achieving a passing grade and once approved, the scholarship winner will receive the applicable Scholarship Value as a reimbursement from the CT CCIM Chapter. Scholarships will be awarded for designation courses taken between August 5, 2022 – December 31, 2022. **The scholarship will not be awarded for courses taken prior to August 5, 2022.**
