### STUDENT ATTENDANCE

Classes start at 8:15 a.m. and end at 3:00 p.m. Students should be dropped off no earlier than 7:50 a.m. and no later than 8:05 a.m. Students should be picked up by 3:15 p.m.

<u>Leaving School Early:</u> Parents who wish to pick up their child early must present a picture ID and must arrive in the main office **before 2:40 p.m.** NO early pick-ups will be allowed after 2:40 p.m. (12:10 p.m. on early release days). The bus loop must be cleared by 2:40 p.m. to allow MCPS buses to enter the parking lot.

Please be advised that we have put this process in place to minimize classroom interruptions and maximize classroom instruction. On the morning of the early dismissal, students should bring in a handwritten and signed note from a parent stating the time he/she will be picked up and the reason. This note is to be given to the secretary in the main office when the student arrives at school. A pass will be given to the student to leave class and be ready in the main office at the desired time. The student must be signed out by a parent/legal guardian. If another relative will be picking up the student, his/her name must be indicated on the note and the named individual will be required to present a picture ID in the main office.

Emails will not be accepted for early dismissal on the day of the dismissal. Please do not call ahead and ask us to have your child "waiting" for you. We will not support your request because we value every minute of instructional time. We appreciate your support and cooperation.

Students Absences: Parents should call the school on any day when a student is absent. A note will be required within three (3) days after the child's return in order for the absence to be excused. Please send the note to the attendance office when your child returns to school. ## STUDENT FOOD & NUTRITION

MySchoolBucks is an optional service for parents to view recent purchases and make prepayment to your child's cafeteria account for breakfast, lunch, and a la carte meals via the internet with a credit card. You will need a valid e-mail address, your child's student ID, and a credit card number. You must enter your child's name as it appears on the child's school records. You may add all your children who attend MCPS on this account. The company charges \$1.95 per credit card transaction. Please create an account by visiting the My School Bucks website: MySchoolBucks

You can request an e-mail be sent to you when your child's lunch account balance reaches a certain amount. Parents can make one-time payments, or you may choose to enroll on auto-pay to fund the account a set dollar amount each month. You can also set up to fund the account once the account is below a certain dollar amount. This way your child never runs out of money. # FREE AND REDUCED-PRICE MEALS (FARMS)

Students may qualify for free or reduced-price meals based on household size and income. They may also qualify if they are receiving Food Supplement Program (FSP) or Temporary Cash Assistance (TCA) benefits. Families may apply for meal benefits by completing an Application for Free and Reduced-Price Meals for the current school year and may apply at any time during the school year. Please remember that you must reapply every school year. **All families are responsible for any negative lunch balance incurred prior to FARMS benefits approval.** If you have any questions, please feel free to contact the Division of Food and Nutrition Services at 240-740-7400.
