Frequently asked questions

- Whole blood donation is approx. 40-50 minutes. Platelet donation is approx.
 (2) hours. Both types of blood products are badly needed.
- All donors must present a <u>photo</u> ID at the registration (employee ID, driver's license, passport, etc.)
- Be at least <u>17yo. and weight of 110 lbs.</u>on the day of donation.
- If you are uncertain of your eligibility, call center at 202/476-5437 from 7:30am – 4pm (Monday – Friday).
- Parking validation for all donors; use garage is under the hospital, off of Michigan Avenue NW.
- **No fasting before/after donating.** Eat a good breakfast/lunch prior to donating and drink .16oz of water on day of donation.
- No physical exercise/workouts after donating; you could have a reaction if you do so.
- Platelet donors should not take aspirin or aspirin products 48 hours prior to donating.
