## TAGT Scholarship Application Instructions

Please read these instructions carefully prior to completing a TAGT scholarship application.

- All TAGT scholarship applications must be submitted by Friday, April 15, 2022.
- Applicants in public schools <u>must</u> be currently identified as gifted and receiving services in a gifted program. Verification <u>must</u> be obtained by providing a name of a campus G/T specialist, G/T classroom teacher, counselor, or district G/T coordinator that can verify G/T status.
- Students in private schools or home-schools are eligible to apply; there <u>must</u> be supporting documentation through previous public-school testing, Mensa membership, or outside psychological testing. Contact TAGT for additional information.
- Student applications <u>must</u> be the work of the student.
- Applicants must adhere to the space limitations.
- Applicants must <u>not</u> submit samples of their work or any portfolio items that are not asked for. All extra materials will be removed from applications prior to evaluation.
- Submit only the required number of recommendations. Any additional letters of recommendation will be removed from the application prior to evaluation.
- The best-written responses discuss the strengths of the applicant and give detailed examples. They are specific to the individual and help the evaluators understand the personality of the applicant.
- Incomplete applications are not considered. It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that the application is complete. See each application for a complete list of required materials.
- No more than one TAGT Summer Scholarship is awarded to a student within a three-year period.
- The maximum amount for a TAGT Summer Scholarship award is \$400.
- Please note that TAGT does not run any summer programs.
- TAGT Summer Scholarships are contingent upon acceptance into the summer program of your choice. Scholarship checks are made payable to the program or the parent of the scholarship winner if tuition has been pre-paid.
