REIMBURSABLE EXPENSES THROUGH CARES ACT FUNDS:

- Expenses for quarantining individuals
- Payroll expenses for those mitigating COVID-19
- Improvements made to teleworking capabilities
- Providing paid sick/medical leave
- Sanitation and social distancing improvements for prisons and jails
- Expenditures for payroll support programs
- Unemployment insurance costs

REIMBURSABLE EXPENSES THROUGH FEMA:

- Disinfection of public facilities
- Technical assistance to mitigate threats
- Medical facility services & supplies (eg. COVID testing)
- Establishing temporary medical facilities
- Emergency medical transport
- Non-congregate medical sheltering
- Purchase & distribution of food, medical supplies and PPE
- Communication & enforcement of health orders
- Expenses to ensure public safety

- Expenses for the state share of Medicaid
- Damages covered by insurance
- Payroll or benefit expenses for employees whose work was not directly dedicated to mitigating or responding to COVID-19
