Dear Friend of the Teamsters Union:

The International Brotherhood of Teamsters recently established the new Teamsters Scholarship Fund, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit, to raise money for educational scholarships for the children of Teamsters. Our great international union — home to 1.2 million people across the United States, Canada, and Puerto Rico — will hold the scholarship fund's first fundraising dinner and reception on January 14, 2023, in Orlando, Florida.

We don't want there to be any confusion about our scholarship efforts, so we've attached a Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) document that will hopefully answer any questions that you may have about the new fund.

The Teamsters Scholarship Fund was created so that affiliates, friends, supporters, and partners can make contributions to a fund that is under the oversight of the International Union with a Board of Trustees appointed by the General Executive Board. We also want as many members as possible in our Teamster family to be able to support the educational and professional pursuits of future generations of hardworking Teamsters.
