Commercial Sexual Exploitation (CSE)	► Sexual Exploitation (SE)
➤ Comprises sexual abuse and remuneration in money, goods, or services- or the promise of money, goods and services- to an individual or third party	 An unfair imbalance in power between two or more people person for the purpose of sexual pleasure.
	 Can comprise sexual abuse and remuneration in money goods, or services- or the promise of money, goods and services directly to an individual.




Risk Factors for SE/CSE:
