IB Exam Equivalencies

American University accepts Higher Level IB Exams with a score of a 4 or above with the following exceptions:

- HL Math requires a 6 or above
- HL Math Statistics requires a 5 or above
- HL English A1/A2 requires a 5 or above
- HL Philosophy requires a 5 or above

A maximum of 30 credits from IB exams (or a combination of AP and IB) will be accepted.

Students may use IB exams to satisfy a maximum of 4 General Education course requirements If your HL exam is not listed below, you may still be eligible for credit on a case by case basis.
