FREE DEVICES

- **Computers 4 People** is a 501(c)(3), nonprofit organization dedicated to collecting, refurbishing, and donating computers to individuals and organizations in under resourced communities to promote equity and access to opportunity. To apply for a computer, individuals must reside in NJ, have low income status under 150% of Federal Poverty Index guidelines, and provide a letter of recommendation from a non-profit, school, place of worship, or Jersey City Housing Authority (for confirmed JCHA residents)

- **Lifeline** is a federal program that lowers the monthly cost of phone and internet. Eligible customers will get up to \$9.25 toward their bill. You can use Lifeline for either phone or internet, but not both. Lifeline is available in New Jersey with the eligible telecommunications providers listed below.
