Please read the following instructions carefully. You will need to provide information which will help us identify local precincts according to your home address and shift availability. Please keep in mind, registration is processed on a first come, first serve basis and is completely confidential. Information collected during the application process will be used for statistical purposes only. If you are unable to select a neighboring precinct, you have the option of placing the student on "Standby" or in a neighboring voting district.

Please keep in mind, training is mandatory for all students and guardians. Non registered students will be turned away at training and/or at the polls. U.S. citizenship is not a pre-requisite to participate and Student Service Learning (SSL) credits will be awarded after the current election has been certified. Additional details will be provided at training and available on the Future Vote homepage. So let's get started!

The Future Vote Student Election Worker Program provides high school students with an exciting opportunity to serve as election workers.
