# How to Apply

Application to the PEAC Scholars Program is open to all rising 9th grade students for whom Magruder is their home school.

There are two parts to the application process for the PEAC Academy.

### Step 1 (completed as an 8th grader):

- 8th Grade students will fill out Academy Interest Survey during registration for their 9th grade courses – select PEAC.
- Students must register for Honors PEAC English 9 and Honors PEAC Biology.

Step 2 (completed as a 9th grader): Complete the formal application process which includes:

- Earn a 3.5 GPA
- Online student application
- Four teacher endorsements
- On-site Student Essay
- Student and Parent Agreements
