Before the fair
☐ Ask yourself the following questions:
<ul> <li>Do I want to attend an extra-large, large, medium or small school?</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>What major do I wish to study?</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Do I want to attend an urban, suburban or rural school?</li> </ul>
• Do I want to attend a 2-year, 4-year, single sex or religiously affiliated school?
<ul> <li>Do I want to participate in athletics, clubs, fraternities or sororities, or special programs such as study abroad or cooperative education?</li> </ul>
Research colleges that are attending the fair to determine if they meet your
search criteria.
☐ Make a list of questions to ask college representatives. Try to select questions
that are insightful and not easily answered in the literature or on their web site.
At the fair
☐ Pick up a fair directory and bag for all of the material you collect.
☐ Visit schools that match or are the closest match to your search criteria.
☐ Ask the same questions you have developed to each college representative you visit.
☐ Make notes about information that you found most interesting/helpful.
☐ Be adventurous. Do not just talk to the "well known" schools.
☐ Attend information sessions offered to gather additional resources on the college search process or financial aid.
After the fair
Review information gathered and narrow down your choices.
☐ Email the college representatives as a way to reinforce your interest in their school.
☐ Add your colleges to your Naviance   Student 'colleges I'm thinking about list'.
