



## WHAT DOES IT COST TO GO TO WEST POINT?


Nothing, other than a nominal initial deposit to cover incidentals like a notebook computer. This four-year college experience is a fully funded scholarship, which includes tuition, room and board, medical and dental care, and more. You'll also get an annual stipend of

more than \$10,000 per year to cover the costs of your books, cadet uniform items, and other school supplies. Your only expenditure will be the effort you'll put forth to set yourself up for a lifetime of success.

## WHAT WILL I OWE THE GOVERNMENT FOR MY WEST POINT EDUCATION?

After graduation you will serve on active duty as an officer in the U.S. Army for at least five years, then three years in a Reserve Component. Graduates consider this to be a small payback for the West Point education and leadership experience that's valued at about \$200,000 for the educational benefits and \$395,000 when cadet military training, travel, salaries and benefits are included.

CAREER TRAJECTORY: As a West Point graduate, you'll begin a well-paying, respected, and very rewarding career, as a commissioned officer in the United States Army, leading soldiers from all walks of life. West Point graduates earn a salary of more than \$63,000\* annually, which exceeds the average college graduate's \$55,260 expected salary.

#### **WHAT IS WEST POINT?**

The United States Military Academy at West Point (USMA) is a four-year educational institution located on the banks of the Hudson River, just 50 miles from New York City. USMA graduates successful leaders of character equipped to provide selfless service to our Army and our nation.

West Point provides a 47-month leader-development program steeped in academic rigor, military discipline, and physical challenges, all built upon a moral-ethical foundation. #### SUCCEED

West Point has very accessible, experienced faculty. Classes are small, so professors know your name, and you're never just a face in the crowd. The graduation rate for minority students at West Point far exceeds the national average — about 78 percent of black and Hispanic cadets graduate. Some years, the minority student graduation rate exceeds the class graduation rate.
